New Login Process Through TMHP IAMOnline and Provider MFA Registration for Transition Release 2

Background:

Effective July 10, the Texas Medicaid & Healthcare Partnership (TMHP) will add new applications to the TMHP IAMOnline platform. These changes will continue the transition to TMHP IAMOnline as the new entry point for accessing applications on the TMHP web page.

Key details:

TMHP IAMOnline activation

Texas Medicaid providers will set up their TMHP IAMOnline account to manage services, access resources and perform essential TMHP-related tasks.

To activate their account, providers must:

- Follow the instructions provided in the TMHP IAMOnline emails scheduled to be sent on June 8 and June 15. Activation emails will be sent only for accounts that have not yet been activated.
- Log in to TMHP IAMOnline, create a password and register for multi-factor authentication (MFA) within seven days of receiving the activation email.

After providers have set up their account, they can access their TMHP IAMOnline My Apps dashboard for applications that have transitioned to TMHP IAMOnline.

The following online portal applications will be transitioned to TMHP IAMOnline on July 10:

- Provider check amount
- Fee schedule

- TexMedConnect1 – Acute Care (AC)
- TexMedConnect2 – Long-term Care (LTC)
- Remittance and Status (R&S)

TMHP will notify providers in future articles of the implementation dates as other online portal applications are transitioned to TMHP IAMOnline.
